Regulation of the National Conference of Student Scientific Research Groups

§ 1

National Conference of Student Scientific Circles, hereinafter referred to as the **Conference** organized by the Faculty of Rehabilitation of the Józef Piłsudski Physical Education Academy in Warsaw, hereinafter referred to as the Organizer as part of the promotion program for self-education and improvement of knowledge of young scientists.

§ 2

- 1. The aim of the Conference is to create an interdisciplinary forum for the presentation of achievements of research students in the field of physical education and health science.
- 2. The thematic areas of the presentations during the Conference include: Physical Education, Sport, E-sport, Recreation, Tourism, Rehabilitation, Sport for People with Disabilities, Adapted Physical Activity, Health Education, Cosmetology, Nursing,

Occupational Therapy, Sports Management, Sports Nutrition, The Impact of the Pandemic on the Physical Condition of the Society.

§ 3

- 1. The condition for participation in the Conference is to send an application and an abstract of the research work.
- 2. Detailed information about the Conference will be sent in announcements.
- 3. The deadline for registering for participation in the Conference and sending abstracts will be provided in the Conference announcements.
- 4. Applications for the Conference will be made using the FORMS form to which the link will be placed in the Conference announcements.
- 5. In order to correctly register in the System, the User is obliged to complete all fields marked with the symbol (*).
- 6. The user guarantees that all data provided for registration are correct.

§ 4

- 1. Participation in the Conference is free of charge.
- 2. The Organizer provides participants with: ID, book of abstracts and a certificate of participation in the PDF version.
- 3. The organizer does not act as an intermediary in booking accommodation and meals.
- 4. The Organizer accepts only research papers whose first authors are students (also members of Doctoral Schools) and graduates of the 1st or 2nd degree studies in the academic year of 2020/2021, provided that the authors were still students when writing submitted research papers.
- 5. The abstracts of the papers will be published in the Conference materials in the electronic version and will be sent to the Conference participants.
- 6. Prizes are foreseen for the Laureates of the works distinguished during the Conference.

- 1. Abstracts for the Conference should be sent to the following address: konferencja.skn@awf.edu.pl
- 2. The summary/abstracts should be prepared in accordance with the requirements presented in the Conference announcement, i.e. the text should be prepared in the Microsoft Word version in Polish.
- 3. Detailed editorial requirements of the abstract will be announced in the announcements and will be placed in the tab on the Conference website.
- 4. Forms of presentation : Power point presentation, oral presentation.

- 1. The Administrator of personal data collected from participants and winners is Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw.

 Processing personal data will take place on the terms provided in the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of physical entities with regard to the processing of personal data and in

- 2. The personal data Administrator has appointed the supervising Data Protection Officer who will supervise the correctness of the processing of personal data, and who can be contacted via e-mail address: iodo@awf.edu.pl.
- 3. Personal data will be processed for the purposes of:
- organization and holding of a conference pursuant to Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f) GDPR and Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a) GDPR;
- tax necessary to fulfill the legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator, pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c) GDPR;
- marketing based on the consent of the data owner, in accordance with Article 6. paragraph 1 lit. a) GDPR.
- 4. Providing personal data is optional, but necessary for the participation in the Conference.
- 5. Conference participants who provide personal data have the right to access the content of their data ,and subject to the provisions of law, they also have the right to: rectify the data, delete the data, restrict data processing, transfer data and raise an objection .
- 6. With regard to the processing of personal data on the basis of the consent, the Participant has the right to withdraw the consent to process, at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing, based on consent before it's withdrawal.
- 7. The Organizer will collect the following data from the Participants: name and surname; email address; phone number.
- 8. The Organizer will also collect the following data from the winner: address for correspondence (shipment of the prize); correct tax ID (NIP or PESEL ID Number); name and address of the relevant tax office.
- 9. The Participants of the Conference have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Data Protection Office.
- 10. The Participants of the Conference allow their names and surnames to be used for the purpose of informing (also in the media and social networks) about the results of the Conference.

- 11. The Organizer declares that the data of the Conference Participants will not be processed automated and will not be profiled.

- 12. The data of the Conference Participants will not be made available to external entities except for the provisions provided by law and by entities with whom the Organizer has concluded appropriate agreements.
- 13. The data of the Conference Participants will be kept for the period necessary for its implementation of the above-mentioned purposes.
- 14. The Organizer uses technical and organizational measures aimed at proper protection of entrusted personal data, in relation to the threats and categories of data to be protected.

The Organizer has implemented appropriate measures to ensure

the level of safety corresponding to the risk, taking into account the state of

technical knowledge, the cost of implementation and the nature, scope, purpose and context of the processing, the risk of violating the rights and freedoms of physical entities with varying degrees of probability of the occurrence and severity of the threat. The Organizer, in particular, takes into account the possible risk

of data processing resulting from: accidental or unlawful damage, loss, modification, unauthorized disclosure of data, unauthorized access to personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.

15. During the Conference, the Organizer may conduct photo sessions and film the course of the Conference for the purposes of broadcasting it in the mass media (television, radio, internet, press) or for the purposes of documenting, promoting, advertising the Organizer and other people indicated by the Organizer. Participation in the Conference is tantamount with the consent of the Participant to the recording, use and / or dissemination of image / voice / statements of each Participant in all

promotional and marketing materials, by the Organizer and its related entities without time and territorial limits.

16. Expressing consent is tantamount to the fact that photographs, films or recordings made during the Conference, may be posted on the Conference website or any other managed by the Organizer and be used in promotional materials, also

disseminated for this purpose by means of vision or audio. The Participant hereby waives all claims (existing and future), including compensation against

Organizer due to the use of their image / voice / statements for the purposes specified in these Regulations.

17. By submitting the registration form/ application, the Conference Participant accepts the provisions of this document.

§ 7

- 1. In justified cases, the Organizer reserves the right to introduce changes to the Regulation. These changes become effective upon their publication on the website, no later than three days before the start of the Conference.
- 2. The number of places at the Conference is limited. The Organizer reserves the right to reject an application due to lack of places.
- 3. The Organizer reserves the right to change the speakers and / or the conference program at any time and for any justified reason.
- 4. The Organizer reserves the right to use the e-mail address provided during

registration to notify Participants about any changes to the Conference program, to the regulations and/or for promotional purposes.

- 5. During the Conference, the Participant is obliged to follow the instructions of the Organizer.
- 6. In matters not provided for in these regulations, decisions are made by the Organizing Committee of the Conference.
