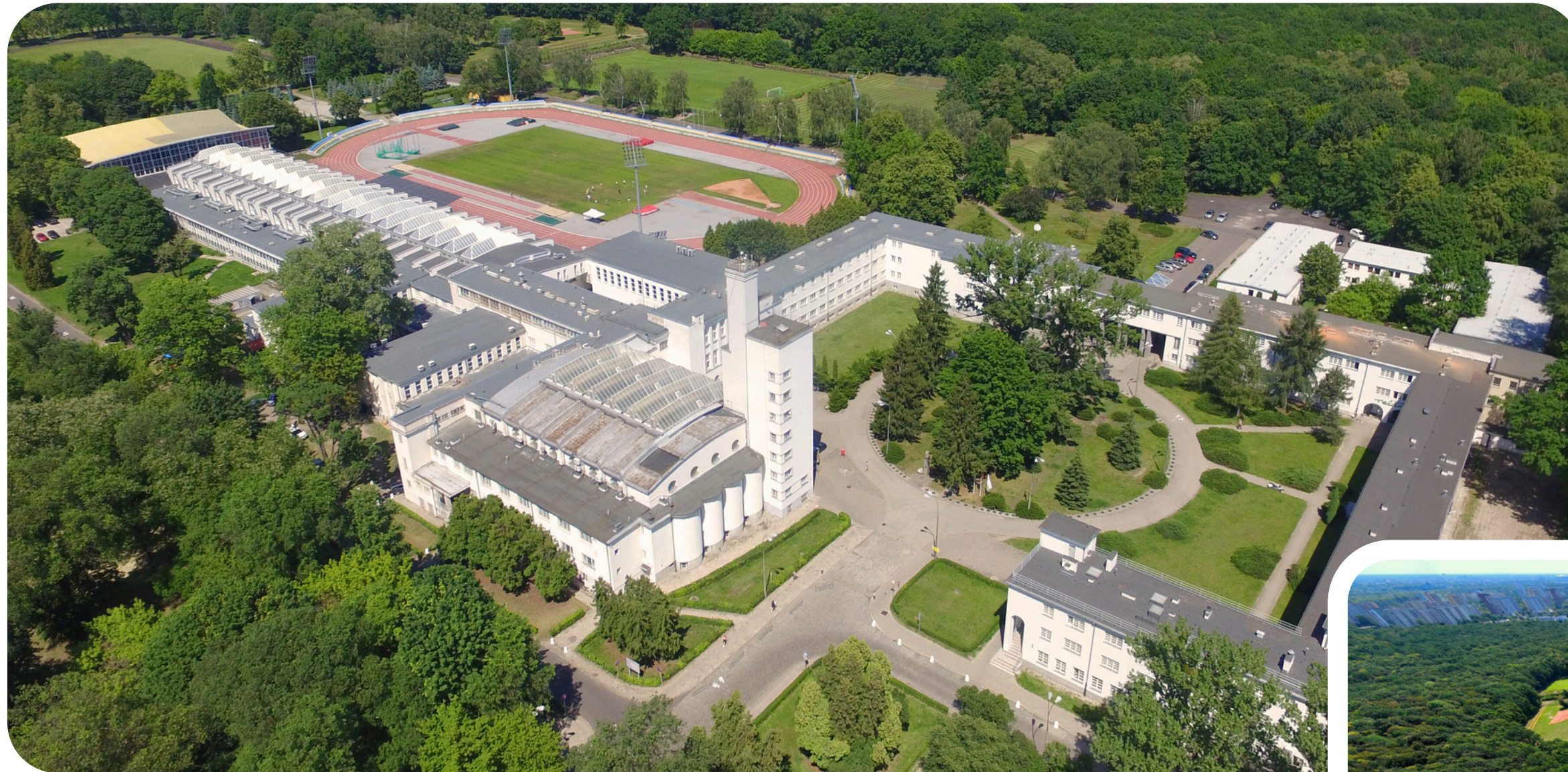


Established by Marshall Jozef Piłsudski in 1929 as the Central Institute of Physical Education - a military professional school.
