<b>Student Application Form</b>	The Student Application Form must be completed and signed by the ERASMUS Coordinator at the home university and returned to our International Office before the application deadlines. Applications will not be accepted after the deadline.

<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>Dormitory on the campus – price monthly approx. <b>150 euro</b> and <b>50 euro</b> deposit (is refunded in full at the end of the semester unless there are deductions for damages). There are mainly double rooms with bathroom and internet connection. The dormitory provides kitchen. Our guest-students should have things for personal use and own dishes.  ERASMUS students have to inform if they are planning to live in our dormitories during the study period (see the Application Form). However it is to stress that we can guarantee a room in our dormitory <u>as long as the semester lasts</u>. The students may <b>check-in one week before the semester begins</b>.</p>
<b>Erasmus Intensive Language Courses (EILC)</b>  <b>Polish language course</b>	<p>In order to learn Polish language you could take advantage of the <b>EILC</b> courses:  <a href="http://ec.europa.eu/education/erasmus/doc902_en.htm">http://ec.europa.eu/education/erasmus/doc902_en.htm</a>; please contact your National Agency in this matter.  Regardless of the above we offer a <b>Polish language course arranged by our University</b>.</p>
<b>Health Insurance</b>	<p>Citizens of the <b>EU/EEA</b> countries should bring an European health insurance card with them. Also an additional private insurance is recommended.  Citizens of <b>non-EU/EEA</b> countries are required to have their own private medical insurance. More information can be found on <a href="#">The National Health Fund website</a>.  <u><b>ERASMUS student must have an accident and health insurance valid in Poland – they can not study nor attend the classes unless they are insured!</b></u></p>

<p><b>Temporary Residence Permit /Visa requirements</b></p>	<p>No visa is required from the <b>EU/EEA</b> member countries. A valid travel document entitles students to enter Poland.  <b>Temporary residence permit</b> is fixed by the dormitory authorities so that it is important to fix the registration formalities at the dormitory right after arrival.</p> <p>All citizens of <b>non-EU/EEA</b> member countries who wish to study in Poland are required to obtain a Polish visa prior to their arrival. They should contact the Polish Consulate or Embassy in their country of residence.</p> <p>Visa requirements and application forms as well as the complete list of Polish diplomatic missions abroad are available at <a href="http://www.msz.gov.pl">www.msz.gov.pl</a> . Persons who have received a visa for the whole period of stay in Poland are not obliged to apply for a residence permit.</p>
<p><b>Required documents after your arrival</b></p>	<p>Original of your signed Learning Agreement  Copy of your ID or passport  Copy of the European Health Insurance Card or other document proving that you are entitled to health insurance cover during your stay in Poland ( private insurance in case of non- European students).</p>
<p><b>Buddy programme</b></p>	<p>ERASMUS students will have a "<b>mentor</b>" nominated by the Students Union.
