

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Scientific Conference

“DanceSport – Research, Practice and Future”

30–31 May 2026

Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw

§ 1. General Provisions

1. The scientific conference “DanceSport – Research, Practice and Future” shall take place on 30–31 May 2026 at the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw.

2. Definitions

For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions, the following meanings of terms shall apply:

- a) Conference – the scientific conference “DanceSport – Research, Practice and Future” (DanceSport – Research, Practice and Future), held on 30–31 May 2026 at the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw;
- b) Organizer – the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw and the Polish Dance Sport Federation (PZST);
- c) User – any person using the System for the purpose of registering for the Conference;
- d) Participant – a natural person who has reached the age of 18 and has full legal capacity, a legal person, or an organizational unit without legal personality, who has duly completed registration via the System; participation of minors is permitted solely as passive participants, subject to the consent of a legal guardian;
- e) Active Participant – a Participant submitting a scientific presentation, the abstract of which has been accepted by the Scientific Committee;
- f) Passive Participant (listener) – a Participant taking part in the Conference without presenting their own work; a passive participant may also be a minor, provided that consent of a legal guardian has been obtained;
- g) Conclusion of the participation agreement – confirmation of acceptance of the application by the Organizer via the System;
- h) Number of places – the number of Conference participants is limited; qualification is determined by the order of applications.

3. Additional information

- a) Official information regarding the Conference shall be published on the Organizer's website at the following address: https://www.awf.edu.pl/wr/nauka/konferencje-i-seminaria-naukowe/skn/_recache
- b) The scope of the System includes registration of participants and handling of the application process by the Organizer;
- c) Use of the System requires access to a device with Internet access and a web browser;
- d) The provisions of these Terms and Conditions constitute an integral part of the application for participation and are binding upon all Participants.

§ 2. Registration for participation in the Conference

1. Registration shall be carried out exclusively electronically via the application form.
2. Registration deadlines:
 - a) active participation – until 26 April 2026,
 - b) passive participation – until 25 May 2026.
3. The Participant is obliged to provide true and complete data.
4. After completing registration, the Participant shall receive confirmation of the application by email.
5. The Organizer may reject an application that does not meet formal requirements.

§ 3. Active participation

1. A condition for active participation in the Conference is registration via the application form and submission of an abstract in accordance with the Organizer's guidelines.
2. Abstracts shall be subject to evaluation by the Scientific Committee.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to reject an application or to request revision of the submission.
4. The form of presentation shall include an oral presentation (8 minutes of presentation + 2 minutes of discussion).

§ 4. Fees

1. Participation in the Conference is free of charge for passive participants (listeners).
2. Information regarding any fees shall be provided in conference announcements.

§ 5. Consent to the use of image

1. During the Conference, the Organizer may conduct photographic sessions and record the course of the Conference for the purposes of broadcasting in mass media (television, radio, Internet, press) or for documentation, promotion, and advertising purposes of the Organizer and other entities indicated by the Organizer. Participation in the Conference shall be equivalent to the Participant granting consent to the recording, use and/or dissemination by the Organizer and entities affiliated with it of the image/voice/statements of each Participant in all promotional and marketing materials, without time or territorial limitations.

2. Granting consent shall be equivalent to acknowledging that photographs, films or recordings made during the Conference may be placed on the Conference website or other websites managed by the Organizer and used in promotional materials, including dissemination by means of visual and/or audio transmission. The Participant hereby waives all claims (existing and future), including claims for remuneration against the Organizer, arising from the use of their image/voice/statements for the purposes specified in these Terms and Conditions.

3. The consent shall include the use of materials without time or territorial limitations.

§ 6. Information Clause (GDPR)

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), the following is hereby informed:

1. The controller of your personal data is the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw, with its registered office at ul. Marymoncka 34, 00-968 Warsaw (hereinafter: "AWF Warsaw"), represented by the Rector.
2. The controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who may be contacted via email at: iodo@awf.edu.pl or by post at the address of the controller's registered office.
3. Personal data shall be processed for the purpose of:
 - a) organization and conduct of the Conference "DanceSport – Research, Practice and Future", including registration of participants and verification of meeting participation requirements – on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) and (f) GDPR;
 - b) fulfillment of accounting and tax obligations resulting from legal provisions – on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) GDPR;
 - c) informational and promotional activities related to the Conference – on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) GDPR (consent).
4. Recipients of personal data may include:
 - entities authorized under legal provisions,

- persons authorized by the controller,
 - entities processing data on behalf of the controller (e.g., IT services, registration system).
5. Personal data shall not be transferred outside the European Economic Area.
 6. The Participant has the right to:
 - access their data,
 - rectification,
 - erasure or restriction of processing,
 - objection,
 - data portability.
 7. Where data are processed on the basis of consent, the Participant has the right to withdraw such consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to withdrawal.
 8. Provision of personal data is voluntary; however, it is necessary for participation in the Conference. Failure to provide data shall prevent participation in the event.
 9. Personal data shall be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of the Conference, and with regard to accounting documentation – for the period required by law.
 10. The Participant has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
 11. Personal data shall not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

§ 7. Final provisions

- The Organizer reserves the right to change speakers and/or the Conference program at any time, without stating reasons.
- The Organizer reserves the right to use the email address provided during registration to notify Participants of changes to the Conference program, these Terms and Conditions, and for promotional purposes, provided that the Participant has given consent.
- Participants shall bear full financial liability for any damage caused by them on the premises where any Conference-related activities are conducted.
- The Participant acknowledges that in the event the Organizer determines that the Participant violates the provisions of these Terms and Conditions, the Organizer shall be entitled to deny the Participant the right to participate in the Conference and to request that the Participant leave the Conference venue or the premises where the Conference is held.
- During the Conference, the Participant is obliged to comply with any organizational instructions issued by the Organizer; this includes, in particular, prohibitions on recording (audio and/or video and/or photographic) of presentations.
- Registration as a Conference Participant shall be equivalent to acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

- Any disputes arising from participation in the Conference shall be resolved by the court having jurisdiction over the Organizer's registered office.
- In matters not regulated herein, decisions shall be made by the Organizer.
